The scope of works shall be as described in the tender document.

Eligible bidders must also submit the following among other eligibility requirements listed in the instruction to bidders;

- a) The tender document must be accompanied by Original Tender Security of **Ksh 200,000** (Two Hundred Thousand Shillings only) issued in Kenya shillings or a freely convertible currency and in the form of bank guarantee or an insurance guarantee from PPRA approved insurance company/ deposit taking microfinance institutions, SACCO societies, Youth Enterprise Development Fund or Women Enterprise Development Fund in the **standard format** provided in the tender document and valid for a period of 120 days from the date of tender opening
- b) There shall be **MANDATORY** organized **pre-tender site visit** on **the dates and time specified in the table above**. *No attendance exemptions shall be granted.*
- c) The attendance register and certificate of site visit shall be signed at the end of the pre-tender site visit by the bidder and witnessed by the Procuring Entity representative on the date of organized site visit. Every bidder shall be represented by one technically qualified person bearing a letter from the company authorizing them to represent the company in the pretender site visit. **One (1)** person shall only represent one company. The letter shall be in the official company letter head giving name and National Identification / Passport No. of the representative who shall be required to present their original identification during the pre-tender site visit.
