TENDER CLARIFICATION - TENDER FOR PROVISION OF COMPREHENSIVE GROUP MEDICAL INSURANCE COVER (BOARD AND STAFF)

Pursuant to Section 75 of the PPADA, 2015, Kenya Wildlife Service wishes to clarify the following:

1. SECTION III - EVALUATION AND QUALIFICATION CRITERIA The following Mandatory Requirement on Page 35 - 36 of the tender has been revised to read as per the table below:

REVISED	Premium turnover: The tenderer shall submit extract of certified audited financial statements or Extracts of IRA Returns indicating a minimum annual medical insurance premium handled of Kshs. 600 million for year 2020 and 2021 (Excluding Medical Fund Management).
