This **Request for Prequalification (RFPQ)** invites applications from qualified firms with demonstrable expertise in ERP implementation, customization, and support. The objective is to **identify and prequalify competent vendors** who will subsequently be invited to participate in the detailed **Request for Proposal (RFP)** stage.

Through this initiative, KWS aims to:

### 1. INTRODUCTION

The prequalification aims to identify firms with proven technical, financial, and operational capability to supply, install, configure, and support a comprehensive ERP solution that meets KWS's business and operational requirements.

The objective of this prequalification is to shortlist competent vendors who will be invited to participate in a subsequent **Request for Proposal (RFP)** process for the implementation of the ERP system.
